



The project

EDDI project aims to help teachers, families and students to better understand the causality and consequences of leaving education in order to find possible solutions to the ESL problem. We believe that only a comparative analysis of practices and interventions between countries which do well in the ESL statistics and those at the opposite end of the spectrum would deliver a sustainable solution to the ESL problem. Besides economic and social mobility impacts, ESL has been linked to bullying, violence or micro criminality. ESL is a threat to the successful future development of the workforce and community prospects.

The Project is funded by the European Commission in the framework of Erasmus+ programme - KA2 Strategic Partnerships in the Field of Youth - and will run for 30 months (November 2020 – April 2023)

- Raising students' motivation to learn
- Improving competences linked to the teachers' professional profiles
- Providing teachers with a resource of ready- to- use materials to prevent ESL
- Involving students, families, health and social agencies
